

We appreciate you joining us.
Ken
Sorry for the technical difficulties earlier, but we are glad you are here to talk with us because I am personally excited and scared to go to the Great American Beer Festival.
Ken
There are plenty of websites that try to tell you you know, first Timers XP.
Ken
Parents, I know porch drinking has a massive list of different events as well as things to do and what to do and not do at the festival.
Ken
So my first question to you regarding the festival, what is probably the most common mistake?
Ken
A new person who's who's dabbled in beer festivals?
Ken
Gone to plenty of them may make when I go to an event like that and how can I not make?
We get.
Ann Obenchain
Well, I think.

Ann Obenchain Being too excited is a mistake and thinking it's a Sprint and the festival is really a marathon. We've got 2000 beers. Ann Obenchain From 500 breweries. Ann Obenchain 384,000 square feet, so that's a lot of football fields to cover. So you gotta wear some good shoes. But just take your time, take it all in, come with a plan and enjoy yourself. Ken Now, I was actually talking to someone on your Twitter account earlier. Ken You guys actually have an app for the event. Ken How is that? Ken Is that this the first year you use an app as opposed to just having like a beer list or a a centralized location? Ken And what can I get from utilizing your app? Ann Obenchain We it's called mydb and it is a browser based app that is free and we've had it a few years. Ann Obenchain So we're bringing it back by popular demand and what it does is it. Ann Obenchain Has beer tours by style, so if you're. Ann Obenchain

New and you want to just.

Taste only one type of beer style.

Ann Obenchain



Ann Obenchain Wear some very comfortable shoes. Ann Obenchain You're going to be walking on car. Ann Obenchain And and just take your time, I mean we'll have there's lots and lots of different areas where you can relax. Ann Obenchain There is the. Ann Obenchain Backyard, where you can hang out in some add, are on deck chairs. Ann Obenchain Play some *******, play some other games, stop and listen to the music at the icon. Ann Obenchain Hey Icon Pass stage, we've got live music every night, every session. Ann Obenchain You can also sit down in. Ann Obenchain The Brewer studio which is. Ann Obenchain Every half hour we're running talks from Bullers or other people in the brewing industry, and you can learn things about pairing food and beer. Ann Obenchain You can learn about just a personal story, so that's another great place to take a load off your off and take a rest. Ann Obenchain For a minute, but you know the sessions go from in the evening sessions or you know 530 to 10. So 4 1/2 hours of sampling beer and. Ann Obenchain

How many people are on the staff that go into making this festival whole and when do you guys start preparing?

Ann Obenchain

Well, we start preparing, I mean we start preparing by securing the dates of the festival years in advance and it is really a year round planning process.

Ann Obenchain

We have our core staff is about 55 people in our office in Boulder, Co, but then we add contractors and then most importantly.

Ann Obenchain

We have more than 2500 volunteers that are onsite and really help us make that happen.

Ken

And do you guys do any other types of events outside of the festival during festival weekend or is that kind of the the community that does all these different?

Ken

A. Events that go on and for those of you who are listening to the podcast or checking us out on YouTube, go into the show notes.

Ken

There is going to be a link to porch drinking which you'll be able to get a massive list by day of all the events that are going on concurrent with the festival.

Ann Obenchain

So we were we. This is our only event. 40,000 people over three days and four sessions is is enough for us.

Ann Obenchain

But we are proud to work with, visit Denver and be part of Denver Beer Week.

Ann Obenchain

So that is usually a week that starts actually tomorrow and runs through the end of Great American.

Ann Obenchain

Beer festival, and that's where we they have lots of other activities all through the city. You know, there's more, more than 100 breweries just in Denver Metro area, a lot of the breweries.

Coming in for the festival or doing special tapings? Ann Obenchain We post quite a few other what we call JAB Week events on our site. Ann Obenchain Porch drinking does a great job of posting events, and then the Denver Beer Week page has lots of events, so we have quite enough on our plate and we're happy to be a cornerstone. Ann Obenchain Of Denver beer week. Ann Obenchain And there are there's. Ann Obenchain Just so much to do. Ann Obenchain At for beer lovers over the next seven days. Ken Now before I pass it to rob, my my last question I want to ask you involves kind of like a comparison and contrast, because here in Detroit, while we do have some public transportation, it is severely lacking. Ken With over 100 in Detroit or city Denver, Metro 100 different breweries all these events, how do people get around the city? Ken Is there a a train, a tram, a? Ken Monorail anything that helps people move from one site to another. Ann Obenchain Yeah, well, there's everything. Ann Obenchain There is the light rail that runs right to the Convention Center. Ann Obenchain From the airport, so if you're flying in, you can take that right to gybe.

Ann Obenchain There is an extensive RTD bus system as well which comes out of Union Station, so that's only a few blocks away. Ann Obenchain And then there's Uber and petty cabs and other rideshares so lots of ways to get around the city. Ann Obenchain I'm so you can leave your car at home. Robear More and more proof that Detroit needs a better public transportation system that will never happen in our lifetimes. Robear And not in our children lifetimes. Robear Nick, I know you feel it. Robear It's great. Nick No, no, it's it's a totally different topic. Nick Topic of conversation, but I am right there with you. Robear Yeah, yeah, yeah, that is. Nick I'm right there with you. Robear

And especially, you know, considering I I was just in in DC and unfortunately I flew into the wrong airport, which did not have a rail system going from Dulles into DC.

Robear


Metro so yeah, the Uber for for 40 bucks was was kind of a pain.



But as interests mentioned with needing that many, you know, needing extra pairs of shoes that there is



Ann Obenchain All the beer that you sample, you can just sample it and then dump it or you know whether you like it or not. Ann Obenchain But you don't have to drink the whole sample that you're given. Robear And I guess not as you mentioned with. Robear With samples and I'm not sure how it works in. Robear In terms of other states, 'cause, what we have in Michigan is that we have our little token system. Robear You have to purchase a ticket to get into the festival and you get a set amount of tokens. Robear You can buy tokens about to get more beer. Robear Is it the same out there? Ann Obenchain It's not so you, you buy a ticket for the festival and then you go in and you get a glass and it is one out samples all night so you do not have to buy tokens. Ann Obenchain And so that's where we really encourage people to savor the flavor, take some time out. Ann Obenchain Make sure you know you grab some food at one of the food trucks or. Ann Obenchain Some of the other concessions.

And dumb you take your time.
Robear
Yeah and it's one out.
Robear
So we're we're used to to four Oz out here and.
Robear
And I know with with Ken what would what he does, and it's something that that I've adopted myself, is that, you know, I would only drink half of it and then just pour the rest 'cause I want to be able to, especially with something like this where there are some new breweries and so many beers.

That uhm, I guess in my head.
Robear
Look, but it's supposed to be a sample, so I I guess I have to come.
Robear
To grips with.
Robear
That that's just gonna be me.
Ken
I I want to clarify something real quick.
Ken
I do not dump the beer.
Ken
I ask for half pours.
Ken
I am not an abuser of alcohol like.
I say good.
Robear



Robear
I guess top is.
Robear
About what that was like with having to go through COVID and not be able to have all of these people, all these breweries, to just enjoy.
Robear
The festival and enjoy each other with beer.
Ann Obenchain
That's a great question.
Ann Obenchain
For me personally, this is my favorite event every year, so I was personally crushed that I couldn't be at Jehovah.
Ann Obenchain
And because as you know the beer community.
Ann Obenchain
Is such a.
Ann Obenchain
Collaborative community and it's a warm community and it felt like we just lost seeing our friends.
Ann Obenchain
It's we're like one big family and the beer lovers that come are our family.
Ann Obenchain
So it was it was the challenge for sure.
Ann Obenchain
You know, we we still held the competition.
Ann Obenchain
In 2019 we we pulled that off, but we, you know, we tried to do a little bit of a virtual festival, but there's no substitute for for in person. And you know, a lot of our businesses, a lot of the Brewers, well, all of them, as we all did, we're struggling with, you know, keeping the doors.

They were focused on reinventing themselves, doing curbside delivery, you know, pickup delivery, everything we they could to stay in business and and come out of the other side.

Ann Obenchain

So this festival is really a celebration of them, I think, and the community of beer lovers, so looking forward to seeing everybody.

Robear

And I guess going into the change or the changes that have happened, just like we've said with the with the delivery, the curbside pickups.

Robear

Uhm, I'm guessing there have been some outdoor patio area type things that have happened in the area are.

Robear

Are there any of those particular?

Robear

Uhm, COVID related uhm, items that that have been put into?

Robear

Starting to go.

Robear

Into a little bit of politics.

Robear

So beer politics.

Robear

Uhm, things that have happened in the area that kept these businesses running, are there some that are still running out there that you hope continue or any that you want to just kind of go away now that COVID has sort of gone away?

Ann Obenchain

Well, I think.

Ann Obenchain

I think what's been great, I'll just focus on the QR code.

Like how awesome, you know, the QR code was was going to be dying, it was going to be a dinosaur before COVID.

Ann Obenchain

And now think about how when you've gone to gone to the breweries when you had the touchless ordering systems.

Ann Obenchain

All of a sudden, QR codes, like everybody on this podcast and all the listeners probably know how to use a QR code, and it's like QR codes.

Are back, right?

Ann Obenchain

It's like, I think that's pretty cool.

Ann Obenchain

So, so that's been great and I think, you know, people have just found new ways to use technology, new, new ways to deliver new ways to enjoy beer.

What? What should go away?

Ann Obenchain

Uh, I don't know.

Ann Obenchain

Well, you know, in my in my hometown, I'd like to see some of the outdoor seating go away and some of the streets reopen.

But it's all.

Good, you know, I mean, every once in a while I still try to turn my car down the street.

That's been turned into a outdoor dining area.

How do you?

So we'll see, but that's.

One more before I pass it on to Nick, though.

We will see how how long this one goes, but enough about jabl.

Let's talk about you.
Robear
What is your tell us about your history in terms of beer?
Robear
You know where when you started drinking getting into?
Robear
Getting into craft beer and you know the UM and homebrewers association.
Ann Obenchain
Oh boy, so I grew.
Ann Obenchain
Up in Minnesota.
Ann Obenchain
We would drive.
Ann Obenchain



Ann Obenchain And really I was like, wow, this has opened my eyes on what great beer is and how fun it is to. Ann Obenchain Drink beer. Ann Obenchain Uhm, how I got to where I am today. Ann Obenchain Fast forward, I worked most of my career in the active outdoor and ski industry and entertainment industry and. Ann Obenchain I'd say about gosh know a. Ann Obenchain Long time ago. Ann Obenchain When Dale was just getting Oskar Blues started and hand canning up the street here in Lyons, Co, he knocked on my door. Ann Obenchain I was working for a backpacking company at the time and he knocked on my door with a sample of Dale's Pale ale and said. Ann Obenchain I want to partner with. Ann Obenchain You to market my beer as the backpacking beer. Ann Obenchain 'cause it's, uh, it's in a can and you can take it with you. Ann Obenchain So I worked on a project with him and that was great. Ann Obenchain Fine and. Ann Obenchain



Ann Obenchain
Yeah, hold on.
Ann Obenchain
And then I all of a sudden I get this, this e-mail I'm copied on from Dale to the CEO on peas and says, hey Bob, meet Anne.
Ann Obenchain
I knew her before she went to jail.
Ann Obenchain
Before she went to prison.
Ann Obenchain
But hey, really?
Ann Obenchain
No, seriously.
Ann Obenchain
She's a really great gal and you should consider her.
Ann Obenchain
So that was my introduction, and I was like, Oh my God.

But he really helped open that door and and then here I am now at the Brewers Association, so.

How you know?
Robear
That is. That is amazing.
Robear
Nick, I'll, I'll leave.
Robear
It you see.
Ann Obenchain
And I have not been to prison.

I I was gonna, I was gonna, I was gonna leave it to Nick for the follow up on on incarceration.
Nick
I I didn't want to ask.
Nick
That question, I hope.
Nick
I'm glad that you said cleared up like, no, I.
Nick
Did not know so.
Ann Obenchain
Well, that was just fabrication.
Nick
So let's go back to the festival.
Nick
For a moment you you mentioned how.
Nick
Many breweries get over 500.
Ann Obenchain
We have 500 breweries on the floor. Yep.
Nick
500 breweries on the floor.
Nick
How do you 'cause?
Nick
Obviously you have to draw a line somewhere in the sand.
Nick
Or is it just worse?
Nick

If you apply to be a part of the festival, you get a booth.
Nick
How do you draw the line?
Nick
Or do you say if you want to come to jab and you want to spot it here at the festival, you are welcome to come?
Nick
How do you?
Nick
Manage so many breweries and do you draw the line somewhere?
Nick
Is there a cap as to how many breweries come?
Ann Obenchain
There has to be a cap, you know, especially this year, 'cause, the Convention Center is under construction, so we went from 10 football fields to 6 football fields.
Ann Obenchain
So this we work with our our exhibit company to plot the square footage and go OK, how?
Ann Obenchain
Many? How many?
Ann Obenchain
Physical booths.
Ann Obenchain
Can we fit in here?
Ann Obenchain
And we have.
Ann Obenchain
Yeah, it's first come, you know, we were able to accommodate everyone that wanted.
Ann Obenchain
To come in this.

Ann Obenchain
Year, but we sometimes we have a cap in some years.
Ann Obenchain
We we can't.
Ann Obenchain
We can't fill it.
Ann Obenchain
But it's first come, first serve and usually that registration windows open for a week and we fill up, right?
Ann Obenchain
Away and then we and.
Ann Obenchain
Then our events team does an amazing job of, you know, playing.
Ann Obenchain
I don't know.
Ann Obenchain
What you would call it.
Ann Obenchain
You squish stuff.
Ann Obenchain
Like, oh, maybe over here there's a little extra.
Ann Obenchain
Room and we can.
Ann Obenchain
Get this buddy in 'cause we don't.
Ann Obenchain
Want to say no to anybody?
Ann Obenchain
Uhm, but yeah, it's uh.

Uhm, it's a big process to put that growth plan together and figure out how many people we can fit in there.
Ann Obenchain
And then also.
Ann Obenchain
Figure out it's not just how many booths, but how many bodies are going to be in that hall.
Ann Obenchain
Because then you know, we have to make sure that the fire Marshall.
Ann Obenchain
Is happy with us too.
Nick
The the logistic side of a festival, besides the actual product that out 10s of thousands will be coming in to to sample over the course of three days next weekend.
Nick
Uhm, stuff that we just don't normally think about.
Nick
This is probably one of the larger. This is obviously one of the larger beer festivals in in the country and this is in 2020. What was that grows that up?
Robear
I said hell in the world.
Nick
In the world, OK.
Nick
But this is probably.
Nick
The first year that we've been in a pseudo normal world with COVID.
Nick
Uh, being hopefully on the tail end of it?
Nick
Probably not, but at least.

Nick
To the point where.
Nick
We're not keeping ourselves locked in our homes doing either virtual festival or reduced attendance. Do you feel 2022 is the is the next step, getting back to that pre COVID level of of everything, engagement in attendance hype?
Nick
All the above.
Nick
Do you feel like this year is the first year that we're back to normal at GABF, or do you feel like there's still one or two things may be missing from the pre pandemic with use?
Ann Obenchain
I think it's a.
Ann Obenchain
Step too normal.
Ann Obenchain
You know, like we're we're past the middle rung of the ladder in.
Ann Obenchain
My opinion, you know where.
Ann Obenchain
Uh, people are still, you know, some people are still too.
Ann Obenchain
To stay at home, you know they're.
Ann Obenchain
Not quite ready.
Ann Obenchain
Others are are running as fast as they can into as many people as they can, and so I think we're one year away from normal.
Nick
One year away. So, so.

Nick
You suppose that's a C oh, no, that's fine.
Ann Obenchain
That's just me.
Nick
I, and I think everyone is entitled to.
Nick
Their opinion?
Nick
So you know me, for example, I I sat out all of 2020. I'm a lion season ticket holder.
Nick
We set set, at least at this stage there. I'm a season ticket holder. I sat out all of 2020.
Nick
'cause there was a lot of uncertainty and by the end of the at the end of the day didn't allow anybody in anyway. But anyway, 2021 came rolling around.
Nick
Barely been that vaccinated and I'm sitting in front of 60,000 people granted them. Surprised? Alliance had 60,000 people to begin with because.
Nick
It's the lions.
Nick
So what if you consider jab at middle rung in your own opinion?
Nick
Again, this is just opinion.
Nick
What do you think?
Nick
Is it is?
Nick



Ann Obenchain Oh, wow, 60,000 indoor. Ann Obenchain So I. Ann Obenchain You know, I think that the indoor part and the drinking and eating and being close together, drinking and eating is something that people just need to get comfortable with and, you know, we're seeing. Ann Obenchain We're seeing rates drop, but there's still uncertainty and you know there's now there's monkey pox. Ann Obenchain Now there's other things and. Ann Obenchain It's just like how is. Ann Obenchain I think, I think people need to settle into what a new normal is and and then we'll see and next year we'll have more space again. Ann Obenchain At the at the festival so we'll be able to grow that space again and and test to see our. Ann Obenchain People really ready. Ann Obenchain I think people are really ready, but I still. Ann Obenchain Know I mean. Ann Obenchain I talked to many of my friends and I'd say. Ann Obenchain You know, sample of you know, ten friends, 60% are like, yeah, I'll go to the festival, no problem. Ann Obenchain

And others are like, oh, I'm just not ready yet. Ann Obenchain I guess it's just a little too much, you know, like they're comfortable going to a small concert or they're comfortable going to dinner. Ann Obenchain Out or they're comfortable. Ann Obenchain Going to a dinner party but you? Ann Obenchain You know, a festival. Ann Obenchain 10,012 thousand people a session. That's a, that's a, that's a lot. Just like go into a a sporting event. Ann Obenchain So if you've been to a sporting event or you've been to a big concert, you're probably going to feel more comfortable. Ann Obenchain But I think we're still like when I was saying right that middle wrong or 2/3 up that wrong. I think that's just the place that. Ann Obenchain People need to use, everyone needs to decide for themselves where they're. Ann Obenchain Where they're going to feel comfortable. Nick And that makes complete sense. It took believe me, when I said when I went to that first game in 2021 last football season, I was nervous and. Nick It's crazy confronting him, sitting in front of 60,000 people that I'd never caught it. It took me sitting at a bar with my cousin. Nick Catching it.

Nick

And that was with six people rather than 60,000. But anyway, one last question before I turn it back over to Ken.

I'm sure some of our listeners are going to be in attendance, obviously can and one of our Co hosts, Dan, will be in attendance.

Nick

What breweries are you personally looking forward to trying and this is tough 'cause you have so many, but is there one or two that stick out that you really are?

Nick

Interested in coming and checking out this year at JBS?

Ann Obenchain

Oh, that is.

Ann Obenchain

So hard.

Ann Obenchain

And you know, since we're we represent everyone, I can't have a favorite child, right?

Ann Obenchain

So I I think that, you know, we've got over 400 breweries in the state of Colorado, so me and I get to travel and see them all the time.

Ann Obenchain

And I love every single one of them, but I think my focus is going to be on.

Ann Obenchain

Places that I don't get to.

Ann Obenchain

Get to very often. So I'm going to go to those States and those and those breweries that you know in those the smallest of the small taproom's and really try them and see what they're what they're doing 'cause often a lot of the creativity is coming out of those of those small, small breweries.

Ann Obenchain

So I don't have a specific theory for you, but but that's kind of my plan for hitting the festival floor next week is, is places that I have to fly to instead of drive to.

So just two beers from the state of Michigan, a soccer tux, bonfire Brown and shorts melt my brain.
Nick
Those are the.
OK.
Nick
Those are the.
Nick
Two uh that I would, you know, if I saw him, I'm going to go for him because it's just those are some of my personal favorites and we all know Kim loves Browns.
Nick
They he loves them.
Ken
That bonfire Browns are really good.
Nick
Right, it is really good.
Uh, OK.
Ken
Uh, true to style, like English style brown ale.
Ken
So if you're if you're a fan of that, that is want to go.
Ken

We're going to need better on draft to do.




